CORE VALUES:

• THE GOSPEL (Romans 1:16-17; Ephesians 2:1-10; Romans 10:9-17) Never forget that we are sinners save by Grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone

We believe that the Gospel is at the center of everything we do as believers. This is the greatest news that we will ever hear:

We have all sinned and fallen short of God's glorious standard. In doing so we have all died spiritually and are deserving of the wrath and judgement of the one who created us. But God, in His grace and mercy sent His one and only Son to die on the cross on our behalf. Taking the punishment that we deserved on Himself so that we who believe in His name might be counted righteous by Him placing His righteousness on us. He was buried carrying our sin and shame, and three days later he rose from the dead and conquered all sin and death. Now we can be made alive spiritually through the same spirit that raised His body from the grave. Through His death, burial and resurrection God has graciously extended salvation to the world, and we can accept that salvation through our faith alone in the finished work of His son, not through our own good works.

This message is one that should sustain us through our entire lives. Romans says that this Gospel message is "*the power of God for salvation for all who believe*", and this is not something we accept and then move on to bigger and better things. Now that we have this wonderful gift, we are supposed to take it to the rest of the world. Our lives, and this ministry, will revolve around the Gospel, and leading people to Christ so that they too might call on him and be saved as well!

• DISCIPLESHIP (Matthew 28:19-21; Luke 9:23-27) I am a disciple making disciples

We believe that discipleship is one of the most important aspects of the Christian life. We should all be a disciple in the sense that we are always looking to learn and grow in our faith. We do not reach some milestone as Christians where we no longer need to be discipled. However, this is not where it should stop. That is something that is a good and beautiful. So, in this group we will strive to be real with each other and share our lives with the people in our class. We will strive to encourage others and push them in their walk with Christ. Praying for everyone in the good and bad times! This is something that every believer wants and needs, and we are going to build our community up so that people can walk into our class and find real people, living real lives, seeking real change from a real God. I believe that if we do that, we will find that people will build real relationships with one another in our community that will last a lifetime.

• WISDOM (Colossians 1:9-10; 2 Timothy 3:14-17) Always seeking to know and apply what is biblical and true

We believe that wisdom is something that is extremely important when it comes to navigating the things of this world. Especially in the age of information that we are in. We are constantly being slammed with information and misinformation, and with each passing day it is getting harder to know which is which. These people may be kind and patient, but the are rejoicing in wrongdoing. We as a group will strive to not fall in either of these categories. We will show grace, kindness, and patience to everyone just like how God showed us when He sent His son to die on our behalf. We did not deserve that, but God still showed us love. So, we should do the same to others. Even if we feel that they do not deserve it. At the same time, we will speak the truth in Love, and realize that our love for God and His commandments are greater than our love for our fellow man. We will stand on the truth of the word, and, if needed, we will address sin issues with our brothers and sisters in a loving way so that they might repent and be reconciled.
